Potocki Palace, Rynek Główny (Main Market Square) 20

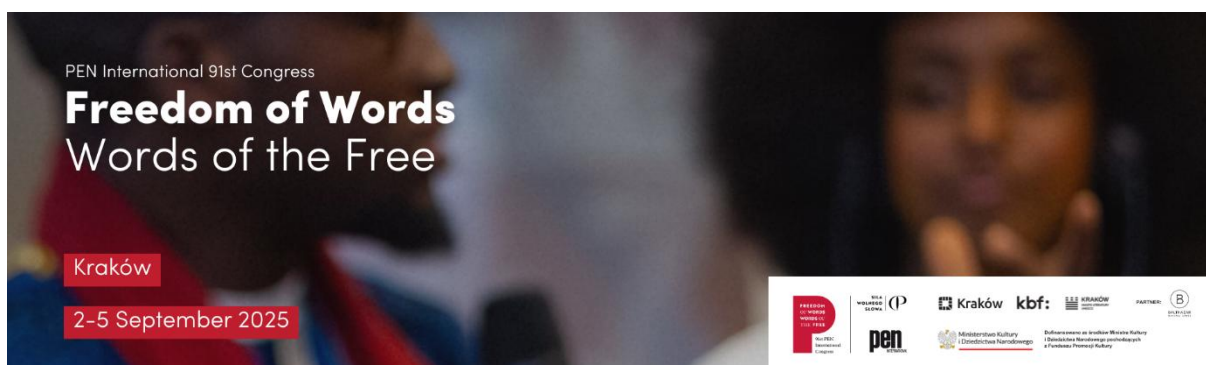

The programme accompanying the congress, which is open to the public, consists of debates with the participation of prominent authors, including Olga Tokarczuk, Raja Shehadeh, Adam Michnik, Andrei Kurkov and important writers and activists from Ukraine, Belarus, Georgia, Lithuania and other countries. The event will be inaugurated with a talk by Margaret Atwood (who will join in remotely) and a meeting with Olga Tokarczuk at Krakow's Kijów Cinema on 2 September.

Poster ≠ Paper

3 – 30 September 2025

Palace of Arts, Plac Szczepański 4

An exhibition that breaks with the common understanding of the poster as an ephemeral message on a scrap of paper. It is a story about a graphic language that does not so much inform as form. About a medium that shapes the visual memory of generations and resonates with politics, art and everyday life. About a form that, although replicated, may be unique.

The exhibition is presented at Krakow's Palace of Art – a historic venue, for decades reserved for painting and sculpture, now opening up to a medium often marginalised in the face of so-called high art. The poster has not so much entered this space as transformed it – on its own terms, with its own alphabet of abbreviation, colour, rhythm. We believe that there is no division between 'high' and 'low' art. There is only good art and bad art. And good poster art has not only stood the test of time, but is returning today with renewed vigour.

The exhibition presents over 200 works by the most outstanding artists: Henryk Tomaszewski, Jan Lenica, Waldemar Świerzy, Andrzej Pakowski, Maria Ihnatowicz, Wanda Gołkowska, Roman Cieślewicz, Wojciech Fangor, and Anna Huskowska, alongside works that are less well-known but equally important for the construction of visual language. We also show design as applied art through the medium of vinyl album, book and magazine covers, as well as logos and packaging.

Through them they learn about the life of bees, apiary work, the importance of pollinating insects and how to help them.

The event includes educational activities for children, young people and adults, promoting pro-environmental attitudes and promoting knowledge about bees, bee products, their properties and possible uses in human life.

Boznańska Intimate

5 September - 2 November 2025

National Museum, Main Building, al. 3 Maja 1

In the Year of Olga Boznańska, the National Museum in Krakow is planning an exhibition dedicated to the artist which will show her as an excellent painter, but will also spin a narrative about her times and everyday life.

For Olga Boznańska, who was educated in Munich and pursued an artistic career in Paris, her hometown of Krakow was an extremely important place. Throughout her life, she was happy to return here and at the same time relieved to leave. It was to Krakow, and to the National Museum, that a large part of the legacy from the artist's Paris studio came. That is why the NMK feels a duty to recall Boznańska's life and artistic journey. The organisers have decided to renew audiences' familiarity with her output by presenting both works that are already well-known and those that have never been exhibited, or that have not been shown for almost sixty years. These include paintings, but also a rich collection of sketches, sketchbooks, youth and childhood works showing Boznańska's artistic development.

The exhibition will feature more than sixty paintings – including above all the portraits that are so characteristic for her, but also still lifes, landscapes and a similar number of drawings, sketches, sketchbooks and completely unknown and surprising childhood works. Memorabilia from Boznańska's everyday life will complement the exhibition.

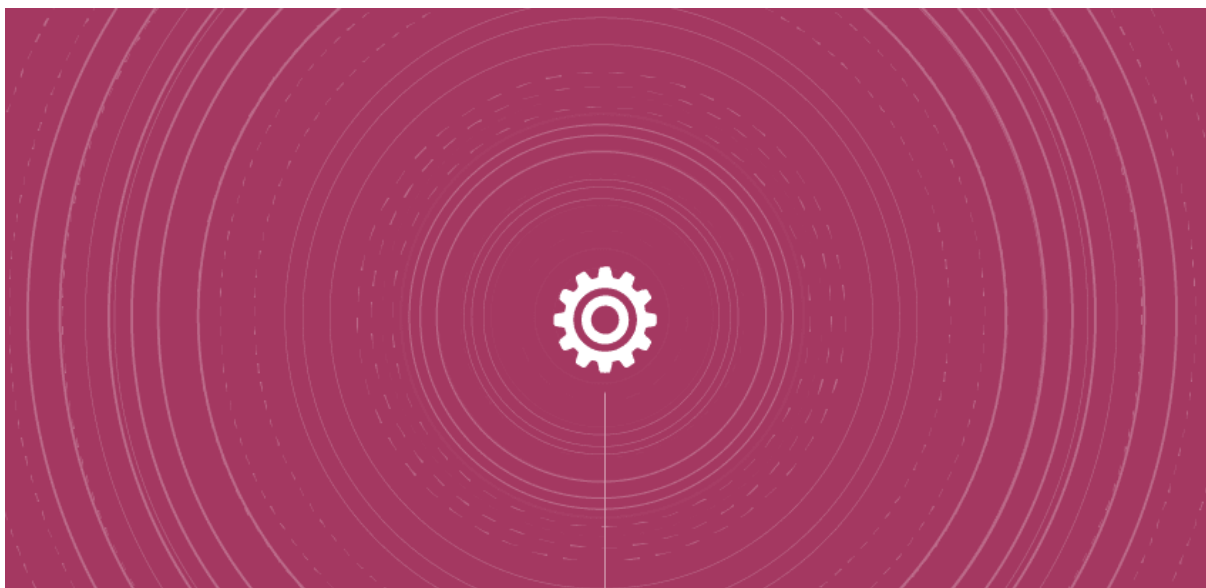

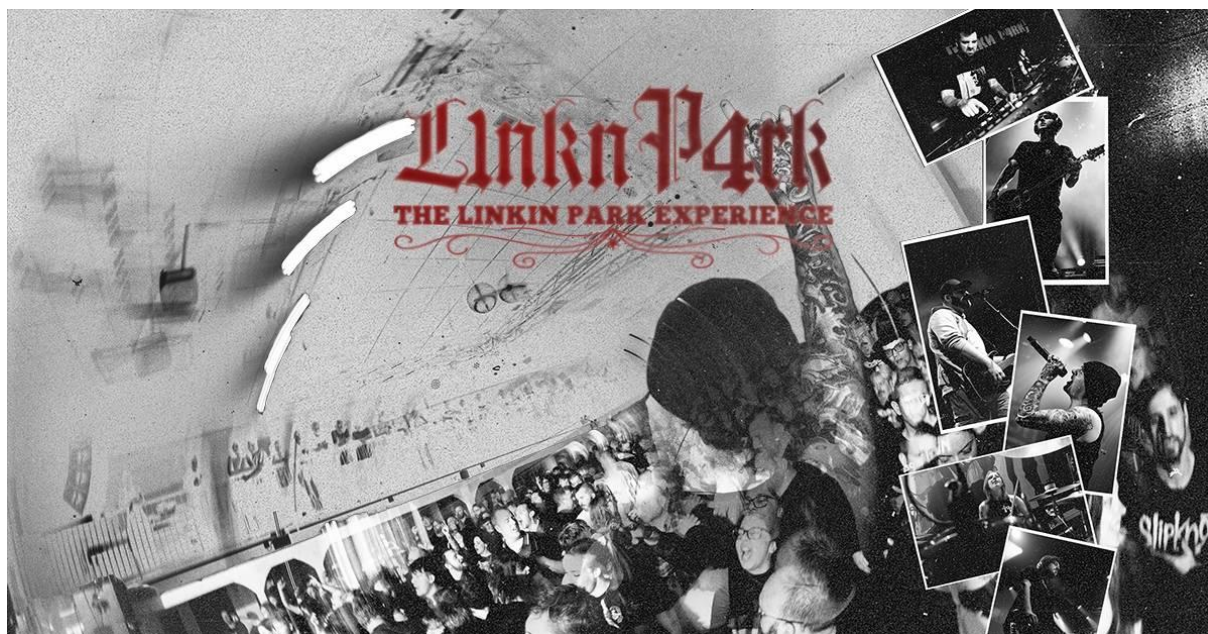

18th PKO Three Mounds Run

21 September 2025

Start: at Krakus Mound

The International Open Krakow Mountain Running Championships is an event whose first edition was organised in 2007. Participants have to cover a 13-kilometre route between three Krakow mounds - Krakus, Kościuszko and Piłsudski.

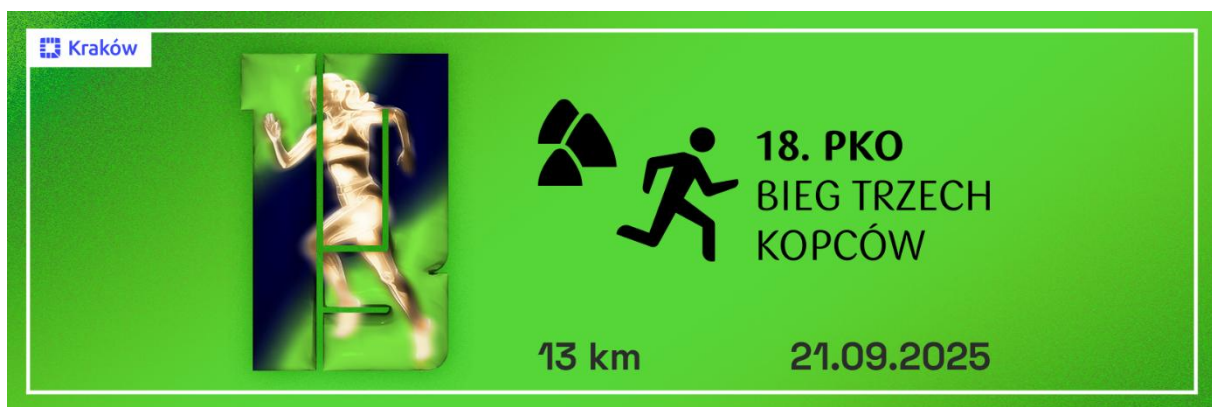
Almost 1/4 of the run follows paths with unpaved surfaces. The difference in elevation reaches 160 m. Due to the variation in terrain, the international classification classifies the run as 'Anglo-Saxon', where the route goes up and down, as opposed to the 'Alpine' version, where the route mostly climbs.

Everywhere along the route, you will see that Krakow offers not only historical monuments and modern infrastructure, but also charming landscapes and natural beauty. Interestingly, this is the only mountain run in Poland that goes through the centre of a major city.
